

Sex Positive Therapist

Arizona Sexual Empowerment and Counseling Services, LLC (AZSECS) is seeking associate or independent level licensed therapists who have some training in sex positive therapy, to provide individual and couples counseling services for adult clients in Central Phoenix. AZSECS is owned and operated by an AASECT certified sex therapist and LCSW, and we provide services to a diverse group of adult clients struggling with various aspects of sexual health and relational needs.

Therapist Job Responsibilities:

- Establish positive, trusting rapport with patients.
- Diagnose and treat mental health disorders and the psychological impacts of sexual health concerns
- Create individualized treatment plans according to patient needs and circumstances.
- Meet with patients regularly to provide counseling, treatment and adjust treatment plans as necessary.
- Conduct ongoing assessments of patient progress.
- Maintain thorough records of patient meetings and progress.
- Follow all safety protocols and maintain client confidentiality.
- Meet regularly with supervisor to ensure patients are receiving the highest quality of care possible.

Schedule, pay, and benefits: Specific hours are flexible but must be on Fridays and/or weekends and/or weekday evenings after 5pm. This is a part time position with hours dependent on caseload and availability. Pay rate will be \$50-60/hour depending on training and experience. The position is a 1099

independent contractor at this time but may transition to W2 in the future. Supervision provided by LCSW. Some funds available to support outside CST supervision if desired.

AZSECS is set up for both virtual and in person services. Candidates who prefer a fully virtual schedule will be considered, but preference will be given to those willing to provide in person services. Most of our prospective clients prefer to come in person due to the high desire for privacy with our work.

If at any time you transition away from AZSECS to your own practice, you will be free to transition any clients who desire to continue their services with you. At AZSECS we believe strongly in client choice and the strength of rapport to facilitate positive change.

Therapist Qualifications/Skills:

- Master's degree in social work, counseling, or marriage and family therapy with associate or independent license
- Must have training and/or experience addressing sexual health concerns in a therapeutic context.
- Ability to demonstrate sex positive therapy approaches
- Excellent communication and listening skills
- Ability to build rapport and communicate with compassion and empathy when working with diverse populations, including gender, sexual, and relational diversity
- Strong ability to manage time and prioritize tasks autonomously

Education, Experience, and Licensing Requirements:

- Master's degree in social work, with LMSW or LCSW
- Other counseling related degree with LPC or LMFT
- LAC and LAMFT will also be considered, though licensure supervision is only available from LCSW at this time.
